



# U.S. EPA FEDERAL FACILITIES ACADEMY

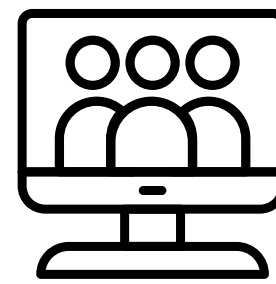

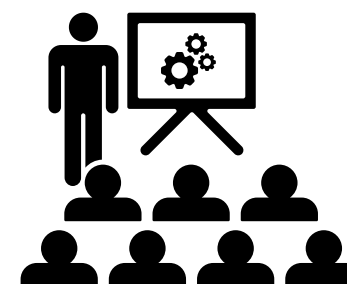
