Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Seattle Area

Average temperatures in February in Seattle range from 40°F at night to 49°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

Trace Market is currently open for breakfast and lunch every day of the week. W Living Room Bar is also available for dinner. The W Seattle is also within walking distance to the historic Pike Place Market which offers more than 50 restaurants to choose from.

Travel Information

The Seattle area is served by [Sea-Tac International Airport \(SEA\)](#). SEA is located approximately 15 miles from downtown Seattle, Washington.

Seattle, Washington is in the Pacific Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

Public Transportation: The Seattle Central Link light rail provides access to downtown Seattle from SEA airport. Trains leave SEA every 15 minutes and the ride is approximately 55 minutes each way. Fares are \$3 one-way. The W Seattle is located near the Symphony stop.

Directions from SEA to the W using the Central Link:

- ❖ At SEA follow signs for Light Rail to Seattle.
- ❖ Exit at the Symphony stop (this stop is approximately a 9-minute walk to the hotel).
- ❖ From the Symphony stop, walk northeast on University Street towards 4th Avenue.
- ❖ Turn right on 4th Avenue and the hotel will be on your right at 1112 4th Avenue.

Taxi: Taxi fare between SEA and the W Seattle is approximately \$50 each way, not including gratuity.

Hotel Parking: Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$68 per night including tax.

Shared Ride Service: Shared ride services such as Uber and Lyft are available from SEA to the hotel. Average fare is about \$50-60 one way, depending on the time of day and not including gratuity.
