Prohibited Items Notice

Per the Interagency Security Committee's (ISC) *Items Prohibited from Federal Facilities: An Interagency Security Committee Standard (2022*), a prohibited item is "...an item, legal or illegal in nature, where possession is restricted from entry into a facility by Federal, State, or local law, regulation, court-order, rule, or Facility Security Committee (FSC) policy." To ensure EPA security policies and practices remain ISC compliant, enforcement of prohibited items lists, and practices are based on this ISC standard.

In addition to any items prohibited by Federal, State, local, and tribal law and/or ordinance, and consistent with the ISC's prohibited item policy, the table below lists the items prohibited by EPA from entering EPA facilities. This list is not all inclusive as [Building Name] may choose to add items to this list in accordance with the current security posture.

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

Bladed, Edged or Sharp Objects **Guns, Firearms and Other Weapons** ▶ BB guns, pellet guns and compressed air guns Axes and hatchets Firearms (unless meeting 18 U.S.C. § 930) Bows and arrows ► Flare pistols ► Ice axes/ice picks Gun lighters Throwing stars (martial arts) Parts of guns and firearms Knives, sabers, swords, daggers, and other bladed devices, except pocket knives under 2 1/2 inches Spear guns Saws, including cordless portable power saws Starter pistols Razor-type blades such as box cutters, utility knives, ► Stun guns/cattle prods/shocking devices and razor blades Realistic replicas of firearms **Club-Like Items and Striking Devices Explosives** Ammunition ► Billy clubs Blasting caps Blackjacks Dynamite Brass knuckles Fireworks Crowbars Flares in any form Hammers Gunpowder Martial arts weapons Hand grenades Nightsticks ▶ Plastic explosives Pool cues Realistic replicas of explosives Ski poles **Incendiaries Disabling/Hazardous Chemicals** ► Fuels, including cooking fuels and any flammable Chlorine for pools and spas liquid fuel Compressed gas cylinders, including fire Gasoline extinguishers ► Gas torches, including micro-torches and torch Liquid bleach lighters Mace/pepper spray/tear gas Turpentine and paint thinner Spillable batteries, except in wheelchairs Realistic replicas of incendiaries Spray paint **4 Penn Center Prohibited Items**
