Sleeping Room Reservations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the W Hotel. The lodging rate is \$248 per night plus sales tax. Reservations need to be made before **June 13, 2026**, to receive the rate.

The rate includes complimentary wireless internet in guest rooms.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. **The hotel requires notice of cancellation 24 hours prior to your scheduled arrival.** If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

The hotel offers \$75 each night for valet parking. There is also self-parking available at the Olympic Garage next door.

Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m. and check-out time is 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Seattle Area

Average temperatures in August range from 57°F at night to 77°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

The hotel has a Market serving breakfast and brunch daily, as well as a cocktail bar.

Travel Information

The Seattle area is served by Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA).

Seattle, WA, is in the Pacific Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

Seattle's Link Light Rail provides access to downtown Seattle from Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA). The Link 1 Line runs daily and takes approximately 35–40 minutes to reach downtown Seattle. Riders can exit at University Street Station or Symphony Station, both located within walking distance of the W Seattle Hotel. Taxi fare from Seattle-Tacoma International Airport to the W Seattle Hotel is metered and typically ranges from \$45 to \$60, not including peak-time surcharges or gratuity. Travel time is generally 20–30 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

Parking is available at the W Seattle Hotel valet service, which is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Valet parking rates are \$75 per night, plus applicable taxes and fees. Additional self-parking is available next to the hotel at Olympic Garage.
