if you are still waiting on approval to attend, please make a reservation to hold your spot at this rate you can always cancel it later. The hotel requires cancellation notice by 6:00 PM, 48 hours prior to your scheduled day of arrival.

The Holiday Inn is located in the heart of the downtown area with easy access to the free 16th Street shuttle (<u>http://www.rtd-denver.com/SpecialRides/MallShuttles/</u>) just a block and a half away. They offer a complimentary high speed internet access, and our special group rate includes a daily complimentary drink coupon that can be used in the lobby lounge. Café 1450 is their on-site restaurant serving lunch and dinner. Parking is available for \$16 a day with unlimited in/out privileges. Temperatures in Denver during late May/early June range from lows in the mid 40s in the evenings to upper 70s during the day. A jacket is suggested. Dress for the meeting is, as always, casual. For those traveling from other areas of the country, remember Denver is located in the Mountain time zone.





Denver International Airport (DEN) is roughly 26 miles (40 minutes driving distance) from the Radisson. The airport offers the services of the following rental car companies: Advantage, Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, National, Payless and Thrifty. There is public transportation available from the airport called RTD skyRide (<u>http://www.rtd-denver.com/skyRide/</u>). They pick up on both the East and West side of the terminal on Level 5. The fare is \$8 each way. You would take the 'AF' to Market Street Station, then

exit the Market Street Station on to 16th Street and take the free shuttle to Glenarm and walk over to the Holiday Inn. Super Shuttle is also an option for \$19 one way or \$34 round trip.
