A block of rooms has been reserved at the Sheraton Denver Downtown in Denver, Colorado. The lodging rate is \$139 per night plus tax which is less than the prevailing federal government rate of \$172 per night.

Reservations need to be made before **5:00 p.m. Mountain Time on Friday, February 19, 2016**, to receive the government rate.



To reserve your room by telephone, please call the Central Reservations office at 1-888-627-8405. You need to mention that you are reserving under the **"EPA Superfund Denver Training March 2016"** to receive the negotiated lodging rate.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Sheraton Denver requires a notice of cancellation 24 hours prior to 6:00 p.m. local time on the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Denver Area

Dress is casual for Denver weather. Temperatures range from 20°F at night to 45°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Ground Transportation

Super Shuttle provides service from DEN to the Sheraton Denver. Ticket counters are located on Terminal Level 5, across from the rental car agencies; reservations are not required. The ticket counter is staffed from 6:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily. If you arrive after hours, please use the courtesy phone located at the ticket counter to connect directly to dispatch. The cost is \$22 per person each way or \$44 per person round trip. For more information or to make reservations, contact Super Shuttle directly at (800) 258-3826 or (303) 370-1300. Super Shuttle features blue vans with SUPER SHUTTLE printed on the side.

Taxi fare between DEN and the Sheraton Denver is approximately \$55 each way, not including gratuity.

Self-parking is available at the hotel for \$34 per night plus tax with in and out privileges. Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$42 per night plus tax with in and out privileges.

From the East:

- ❖ Take Interstate 70 or Interstate 76 West to Interstate 25 South.
- ❖ Take the exit for Colfax Avenue.
- ❖ Turn left onto Colfax Avenue and travel 1.3 miles.
- ❖ Turn left at Court Place and travel two blocks to the hotel.

From the North:

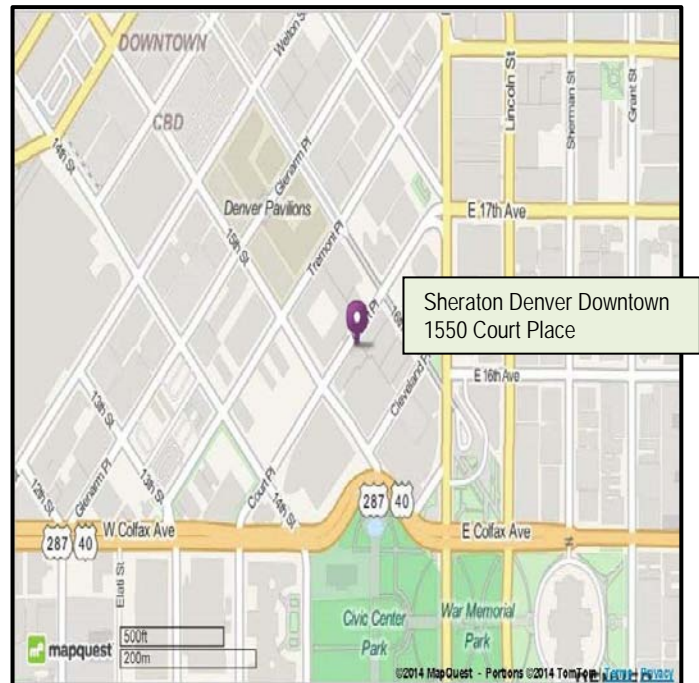
- ❖ Take Interstate 25 South.

- ❖ Turn left onto Colfax Avenue and travel 1.3 miles.
- ❖ Turn left at Court Place and travel two blocks to the hotel.

From the West:

- ❖ Take Interstate 70 or Interstate 76 West to Interstate 25 South.
- ❖ Take the exit for Colfax Avenue.
- ❖ Turn left onto Colfax Avenue and travel 1.3 miles.
- ❖ Turn left at Court Place and travel two blocks to the hotel.

From the South:

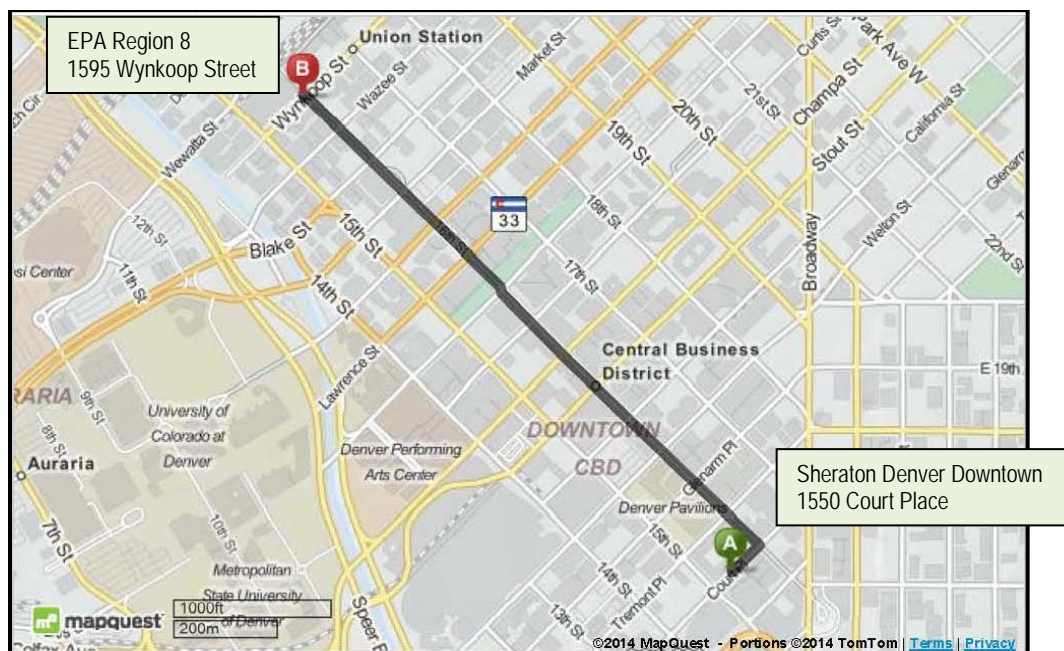
- ❖ Take Interstate 25 North.
- ❖ Take the exit for Colfax Avenue.

Walking Directions to EPA Region 8 from the Sheraton Denver Downtown Hotel

Approximately 1 mile, 20 minutes

- ❖ Start out heading northeast on Court Place toward 16th Street
- ❖ Turn left onto 16th Street.
- ❖ Turn left onto Wynkoop Street.
- ❖ EPA Region 8 will be located on the right at 1595 Wynkoop Street.



16th Street Shuttle

The 16th Street Shuttle is a free shuttle that travels the 16th Street mall. The shuttle is free and is a convenient way to travel to and from the EPA Region 8 office.
