Security Procedures for EPA Region 10 Office

- You need to bring a photo ID and check in at the beginning of each day of your visit.
- Please allow 20 minutes to complete the initial security procedures each day of the workshop. At lunch, screening must happen again, so please allow for 10-15 minutes and bring only the essentials to lunch to allow for quicker screening.
- The entrance of Park Place building is located at the SE corner of University Street and 6th Avenue.
- When entering the building on the ground floor, you will go through standard federal facility security screening including a request to see photo ID, a walk through a metal detector and an x-ray screening of packages and personal items.
- After security please check in at the Service Center. Service Center hours are 7 AM to 4:30 PM and is located behind the security guard desk. All visitors, including family and friends, are required to check in at the Service Center. At the Service Center you will be issued a dated visitor's badge with evacuation directions. The badge must be visibly worn by visitor to identify them as guests here to conduct official business with the EPA.
- Visitors will be escorted to the meeting destination by the EPA host. EPA plans to have people stationed in the Service Center to bring attendees to the workshop and will also provide cell phone numbers for late arrivals.
- EPA employees from operations/field office, HQ and other regions must also check at the Service Center each day of their visit and visibly wear their government ID badge.
- No weapons of any kind are permitted, including but not limited to: Firearms, with or without concealed
 weapon permit, pepper spray and any other personal defense weapon, razors and knives over 2.5 inches,
 other common items that are not permitted include: work tools without a work order to perform work in EPA
 space, and marijuana and medical marijuana, with or without card.
- Elevator security features require the use of a key card to operate the elevators only issued to EPA R10 employees. EPA will post someone near the elevators to assist participants at the beginning of the day and after returning to the workshop from lunch.

Transportation to the Workshop

- The Executive Hotel Pacific and the W Seattle Hotel are located approximately 0.2 miles from the workshop location at EPA Region 10 offices.
- The walk from the W Hotel, Executive Hotel Pacific, Crowne Plaza Seattle, or Sheraton Hotel to EPA Region 10 offices will take approximately 5 minutes.
- The nearest Light Rail Station is University Street, located approximately 0.2 miles from EPA Region 10 offices, also approximately a 5 minute walk.
- Parking is available for a fee in the garage underneath the EPA building and at other nearby locations. The least expensive all-day parking is at the Town Hall building near EPA on the east side of the freeway. This can be accessed from 7th Avenue between Spring St. and Seneca St.

Local Restaurants

- Lunch will be on-your-own, and participants will have an hour for lunch.
- Please allow 10 minutes for screening to rejoin the meeting.
- There are many restaurants within walking distance of EPA Region 10 offices.
- Voxx Coffee is located downstairs in the EPA Region 10 building.
- One Union Square Building Restaurants:
 - To access the One Union Square Building restaurants, from the workshop location, cross University Street and walk about 50 feet. Turn right into the revolving door just past Mod Pizza.
 - One Union Square Building restaurants are: Blue Water Taco Grill; MOD Pizza; Organics to Go; Starbucks; Sullivan's Steakhouse; Tully's Coffee; Fresh Basil; World Fresh Asian Eatery.
- Washington State Convention Center
 - To get to the restaurants at the Washington State Convention Center, continue through One Union Square past the Starbucks, to the second floor and through the back garden area.
 - Washington State Convention Center restaurants are: Juicy Café; La Crêperie Voilà; Goldbergs' 2 Go; Daawat Indian Grill & Bar; Taco del Mar.
- Rainier Square
 - Rainier Square is located at the corner of 5th Avenue and University St. To get there, cross 6th Avenue westward towards the water and cross University St. northbound. Continue westward on University St. towards the water and cross 5th Avenue; the entrance to Rainier Square is on the right, located mid-block between 4th and 5th on the north side of University St.
 - Rainier Square restaurants are: Origins Vietnamese Bistro; Dilletante Café; Medi; Market Fresh.
