Travel Information

Seattle, Washington is located in the Pacific Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

The Seattle Central Link light rail provides access to downtown Seattle from SEA airport. Trains leave SEA every 15 minutes and the ride is approximately 55 minutes each way. Fares are \$2.75 one-way. The Hilton Seattle is located near the University Street Station Bay A stop.

Directions from SEA to the Hilton using the Central Link:

- At SEA follow signs for Light Rail to Seattle.
- Exit at the University Street Station Bay A stop (this stop is approximately a 9 minute walk to the hotel).
- From the University Street Station Bay A stop, walk northeast on University Street towards 6th Avenue.
- Please note the walk northeast on University Street is on a significant grade.
- The Hilton is located at the corner of University Street and 6th Avenue.

Taxi fare between SEA and the Hilton is approximately \$40 each way, not including gratuity. Self-parking is available at the hotel for \$45 plus tax per night with in and out privileges.

Driving Directions to EPA Region 10 Seattle

From Northbound I-5:

- Exit onto Seneca Street (Exit 165), which is a left-lane exit.
- ✤ Turn right onto 6th Avenue.
- The Park Place building will be on your right.
- The parking garage entrance is off 6th Avenue on your right.

From Southbound I-5:

- Exit onto Union Street (Exit 165B), which is a right-lane exit.
- Stay in the left lane of Union Street and turn left at 5th Avenue.
- Drive three blocks and turn left on Cherry Street.
- Turn left on 6th Avenue.
- The Park Place building will be on your right.
- The parking garage entrance is off 6th Avenue on your right.

Walking Directions to EPA Region 10 office from the Hilton Seattle Approximately 200 feet, 1 minute

- Head southeast on 6th Avenue and cross University Street.
- EPA Region 10 will be located on the left at 1200 Sixth Avenue (Park Place Building).
