Please note: The training will be held at the U.S. EPA Region 8 office in the Bison/Bitterroot rooms; a sleeping room block has been established at the Hyatt Place Denver Downtown Hotel which is located approximately 1 mile (approximately a 15-minute walk) from the U.S. EPA Region 8 office.

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Hyatt Place Denver/Downtown Hotel in Denver, Colorado. The lodging rate is \$129 per night plus 15.75 percent tax, which is less than the current federal per diem rate. The rate includes complimentary in-room high speed internet access and a complimentary breakfast.

Reservations need to be made before Tuesday, September 21, 2021, to receive the government rate.

To reserve your room by telephone, please call 888-591-1234 and ask for a room under the "**EPA Federal Facility RPM**" group to receive the negotiated lodging rate. Click here to book your room at Hyatt Place Denver Downtown. You will need to select your arrival and departure dates.

Please note, when using the link, you will only be able to book the contracted dates of the room block which are an arrival of Tuesday, October 12 and a departure of Saturday, October 16. If you try to book an arrival before Tuesday, October 12 or a departure after Saturday, October 16, the link will say "no rooms available." If you need dates before or after the block dates, please contact Jodi McCarty, ICF, at Jodi.mccarty@icf.com for assistance.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Hyatt Place Denver/Downtown requires a notice of cancellation 48 hours before the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 11:00 a.m.

What to Pack for the Denver Area

Average temperatures range from 40°F at night to 70°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

Food service is currently not available at the Hyatt Place. However, the Hyatt Place is steps away from 16th Street, where there are over two dozen restaurants. Delivery service is also available.

Health, Fitness and Recreation

The Hyatt Place offers a fitness center with cardiovascular equipment and free weights available.

Travel Information

The Denver area is served by Denver International Airport (DEN). DEN is located approximately 25 miles from downtown Denver, Colorado. Additional information for DEN is available at http://www.flydenver.com/.

Denver, Colorado is in the Mountain Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

RTD Rail System: Denver's RTD Rail System provides service from DEN to downtown Denver. Upon arriving at DEN, head to baggage claim located on Level 5. To get to the Denver Airport RTD Station, follow signs to the Transit Center and proceed to the south exit on level 5 (look for the large American flag), exit the terminal through the sliding glass doors and take the escalator located in the center of the plaza down to Level 1. The A Line Trains depart to and from the airport every 15 minutes throughout the day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year. Early morning and late evening trips depart every 30 minutes. One-way fares are \$10.50. You must purchase your ticket prior to boarding the train from one of the kiosks located on the platform. To get to the Residence Inn, take the A Line all the way to Union Station (approximately 37 minutes). From Union Station you can walk towards 16th Street and take the 16th Street Shuttle, a free shuttle that travels the 16th Street mall, and get off at the Glenarm Place stop. Head southwest on Glenarm Place toward 15th Street then turn left on 14th Street. The Hyatt Place Denver/Downtown Hotel will be on the right.

Taxi: Taxi fare between DEN and the Hyatt Place Denver/Downtown is approximately \$65 each way, not including gratuity.


Hotel Parking: Parking is available at the hotel for \$25 per night plus tax with in and out privileges.

Walking Directions to EPA Region 8 from the Hyatt Place Denver/Downtown Approximately 1 mile, 15 minutes

- When walking out of the hotel, head northwest on 14th Street toward Glenarm Place
- Turn right onto Blake Street
- ❖ Turn left onto 15th Street
- Turn right onto Wynkoop Street
- EPA will be at the corner of Wynkoop Street and 16th Street.
