# **Superfund CIP and Fact Sheet Templates Webinar Series**

#### TRAINING GOALS

Communication and outreach to Superfund communities, including site specific Community Involvement Plans (CIPs) and fact sheets, are key to meaningful and effective engagement. This webinar series provides hands-on demonstrations of the updated CIP and fact sheet templates, using building blocks within the Microsoft Word Quick Parts menu. The CIP and Fact Sheet Development Teams originally developed the templates in 2020. Participants of the basic trainings will learn how to create CIPs and fact sheets using the templates. The advanced trainings will dive deeper into template customization and creating new building blocks.

- Use the templates to develop customized CIPs and fact sheets.
- Insert and customize modular text and graphic elements.
