The EPA National Site Assessment Symposium (NSAS) training program will be held Monday, December 3 through Friday, December 7, 2018, at the Sheraton Denver Downtown Hotel in Denver, Colorado. EPA Regional Managers and the Association of State and Territorial Solid Waste Management Officials, Inc. (ASTSWMO) will hold their respective break-out meetings on Monday, December 3, 2018 beginning at 1:00 p.m. local time. The training program offers training sessions beginning on Tuesday, December 4, 2018 beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending on Friday, December 7, 2018 at 12:00 p.m.

Onsite check-in for the EPA NSAS training program is available on Sunday, December 2, 2018 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Sheraton Denver Downtown. Onsite check-in will continue Monday, December 3, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.

Sleeping Room Reservations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Sheraton Denver Downtown Hotel in Denver, Colorado. The lodging rate is \$181 per night plus sales tax. Reservations need to be made before **Friday, November 2, 2018**, to receive the group rate.

Included in the room rate is complimentary wireless internet in your guest room and a complimentary hot breakfast buffet each day.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Sheraton Denver requires a notice of cancellation 48 hours prior to 6:00 p.m. local time on the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Denver Area

December temperatures range from 15°F at night to 45°F during the day. Please be advised that temperatures in the training rooms do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a light jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the NSAS training program.

Dining

The Sheraton Denver offers the following dining options:

- ❖ **15 | Fifty Restaurant**, open daily for breakfast (6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.) and dinner (4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.), offers American cuisine and is in the lobby of the hotel.
- ❖ **Yard House** offers American cuisine and is open Sunday through Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. and Friday and Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- ❖ **Peet's Coffee and Tea** is open daily from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and offers coffee, tea, and snacks.
- ❖ **Zoup!** is open Monday through Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. and Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and offers a variety of soup and snacks.

The Sheraton Denver also offers in-room dining 24 hours a day. The Sheraton is also steps from the 16th Street Mall providing easy access to more than two dozen restaurants.

Getting to the Denver Area

The Denver area is served by Denver International Airport (DEN). DEN is located approximately 25 miles from downtown Denver, Colorado. Additional information for DEN is available at <http://www.flydenver.com/>.

Denver, Colorado is in the Mountain Time Zone.

Ground Transportation to and from the Denver International Airport

RTD Rail System: Denver's recently opened RTD Rail System provides service from DEN to downtown Denver. **This is the recommended method of transportation between the airport and hotel.** Upon arriving at DEN, head to baggage claim located on Level 5. To get to the Denver Airport RTD Station, follow signs to the Transit Center and proceed to the south exit on level 5 (look for the large American flag), exit the terminal through the sliding glass doors and take the escalator located in the center of the plaza down to Level 1. The A Line Trains depart to and from the airport every 15 minutes throughout the day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year. Early morning and late evening trips depart every 30 minutes. One-way fares are \$9.00. You must purchase your ticket prior to boarding the train from one of the kiosks located on the platform. To get to the Sheraton Denver Downtown, take the A Line all the way to Union Station (approximately 37 minutes). From Union Station you can walk towards 16th Street and take the 16th Street Shuttle, a free shuttle that travels the 16th Street mall, and get off at Court Place right in front of the Sheraton Denver.

Super Shuttle: Super Shuttle provides service from DEN to the Sheraton Denver. Ticket counters are located on Terminal Level 5, across from the rental car agencies; reservations are not required. The ticket counter is staffed from 6:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily. If you arrive after hours, please use the courtesy phone located at the ticket counter to connect directly to dispatch. The cost is \$22 per person each way or \$44 per person round trip. For more information or to make reservations, contact Super Shuttle directly at (800) 258-3826 or (303) 370-1300. Super Shuttle features blue vans with SUPER SHUTTLE printed on the side.

Taxi: Taxi fare between DEN and the Sheraton Denver is approximately \$55 each way, not including gratuity.

Hotel Parking: Self-parking is available at the hotel for \$40 per night plus tax with in and out privileges. Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$49 per night plus tax with in and out privileges.

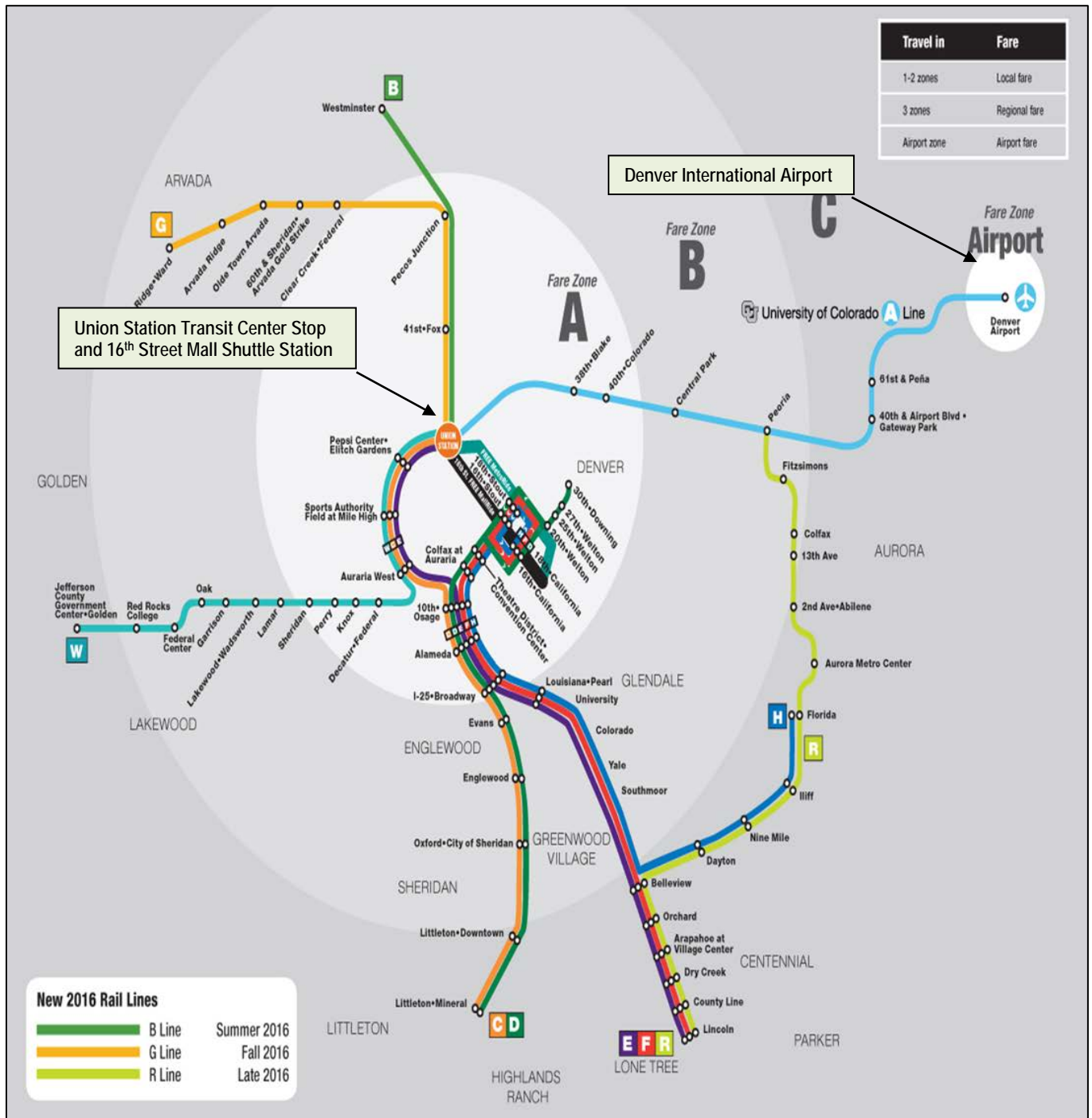
