3.2.7.3 Subpart CC - Containers, Tanks and Surface Impoundments

Subpart CC applies to interim status and permitted TSD facilities that manage hazardous waste in containers, tank systems, surface impoundments or miscellaneous units and large quantity generators (LGQs) that accumulate hazardous waste in tanks and containers. Waste management units that contain hazardous waste with an average organic compound concentration of 500 parts per million by weight (ppmw) or greater are subject to the Subpart CC requirements. Type-specific equipment design and operating practices apply to each regulated waste management unit. In addition, any control device handling emissions from such units must meet the 95% minimum control or 20-ppmv total organic outlet concentration limit for a combustion device. Applicants must submit information that demonstrates compliance with those requirements if the
